We hereby offer our bid for furnishing and delivering processed road gravel as follows:

MAINTENANCE GRAVEL - Furnish and deliver approximately 8,000 cubic yards of Processed Road Gravel (22-A Modified) at Road Commission Yards at Fennville, Diamond Springs, Allegan, and Shelbyville.

The material in the amount shown is to be furnished and delivered at each of the Four (4) County yards listed. These unit bid prices shall be guaranteed until December 31, 2010, for delivery of additional road gravel to any of these four (4) yards, should additional quantities be needed.

The gravel shall meet 2003 Michigan Department of Transportation Specifications 22-A as modified.
