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## FROM THE MANAGING DIRECTOR

The 10<sup>th</sup> Street Bridge over the Norfolk Southern Railroad between 124<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 129<sup>th</sup> Avenue, which we had to close this fall, has just been approved for funding to be replaced in 2006. This bridge replacement was approved in November for 2007 funding, but was able to be advanced to 2006 when some other bridges in the region which had previously been approved for 2006, ran into some delays, and were moved back to 2007. This was a great Christmas present that we received on December 23<sup>rd</sup>. Now we need to finish its design and approvals so that it can be put out to bid in 2006.

## 2005 PRIMARY ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

5. 106<sup>th</sup> Ave. from 10<sup>th</sup> St. to 6<sup>th</sup> St. – 1.95 miles
6. Douglas Ave. from Plainwell City Limit to S. County Line – 1.23 miles
7. 142<sup>nd</sup> Ave. from W. of 16<sup>th</sup> St. to US-131 – 1.52 miles

## 2005 LOCAL ROAD CONSTRUCTION

Two Local Road Bridges were replaced using State and Federal Funding.

1. 120<sup>th</sup> Ave. over the Gun River between Second St. and Patterson Rd. was completed in Martin Township.
2. 112<sup>th</sup> Ave. over Miner Creek between 22<sup>nd</sup> St. and 20<sup>th</sup> St. was started in Otsego and Watson Townships.

### **2005 LARGE CULVERT REPLACEMENTS**

The following large culverts were replaced using a combination of Township and County Road Commission funds.

1. 22<sup>nd</sup> St. south of 130<sup>th</sup> Ave. in Hopkins Township.
2. 18<sup>th</sup> St. south of 112<sup>th</sup> Ave. in Otsego Township.
3. Blue Star Hwy south of 124<sup>th</sup> Ave. in Ganges Township.

### **2005 SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

A curve on Monroe Road between 36<sup>th</sup> St. and 39<sup>th</sup> St. was rebuilt and widened using a Federal Safety Grant.

### **2005 SLURRY SEAL PROGRAM**

The following roads received a preservation slurry sealing.

1. 11<sup>th</sup> St. from 102<sup>nd</sup> Ave. to 0.25 mile south.
2. Gore's Addition on Elmwood, Bloomfield, Bloomfield and Liberty – 0.60 mile
