Gentlemen:

We hereby offer our bid for furnishing and delivering processed road gravel as follows:

MAINTENANCE GRAVEL - Furnish and deliver approximately 8,000 cubic yards of Processed Road Gravel (22-A Modified) at Road Commission Yards at Fennville, Diamond Springs, Allegan, and Shelbyville.

The material in the amount shown is to be furnished and delivered at each of the Four (4) County yards listed. These unit bid prices shall be guaranteed until December 31, 2015, for delivery of additional road gravel to any of these four (4) yards, should additional quantities be needed.

The gravel shall meet 2003 Michigan Department of Transportation Specifications 22-A as modified.

Passing 1" sieve	100%
Passing 3/4" sieve	90% - 100%
Passing 3/8" sieve	65% - 85%
Passing No.8 sieve	30% - 50%
Loss by Washing	6% - 12%

Award of the contract will be made to the bidder submitting the lowest bid for each individual garage, and they may be awarded separately.

All gravel must be tested and approved by the Road Commission before hauling is started.

The project completion date is July 30, 2015, for this initial order delivery, with delivery to begin immediately as allowed by weight restrictions.

CONTRACT EXTENSION – This contract may be extended one year at a time for three years by mutual written agreement of both parties. Request for extension should be submitted no later than March 1, by the contract to be considered.
